Alexis Wright's Publishing History in Three Contexts: Australian Aboriginal, National, and International ("the Article")

The Journal's Editor and Wayne State University Press (the Press) a division of Wayne State University of Detroit, Michigan, is pleased to include your contribution titled above in the journal *Antipodes: A Global Journal of Australian/New Zealand Literature*.

1. As Author(s) of the Article, you hereby grant and transfer exclusively to the Press all rights of whatever kind to the Article, including but not limited to copyright, during the full term of copyright in the United States of America and elsewhere. The Press may register copyright to the Journal issue in which the Article appears.

2. Rights of the Author: You have the following nonexclusive rights: (1) to use the Article in your own teaching activities; (2) to publish the Article, or permit its publication, as part of any book you may write; (3) to include a pre-print and/or post-print version of the Article on your departmental or institutional database or on-line site; (4) to include a PDF of the final, copyedited, and proofread version of the Article as it appears in the journal on your departmental or institutional database or on-line site 12 months after final publication. You agree that you will properly credit the Journal as the original place of publication and the Press as the publisher. You agree that you will notify the Press if you publish the Article, or permit its publication, as part of any book you may write before the book is published or within 30 days after the publication of the book.

3. Rights of the Press: The Press's rights include but are not limited to the following: (1) to publish the Article in any media, whether paper or electronic or other forms yet to be invented; (2) to license abstracts, quotations, extracts, reprints, and/or translations of the work for publication; (3) to license reprints of the Article to third persons for educational purposes; (4) to license others to create abstracts of the Article and to index the Article; (5) to license secondary publishers to produce the Article in print, microform, or any computer-readable form, including electronic on-line databases or other forms yet to be invented; and (6) to license the Article for document delivery.

4. Warranties: You represent and warrant to the Press that the Article is original, that you have full power to make this Agreement, that you are the sole author(s); that you have not previously published, or agreed to publish, the Article in whole or in part elsewhere, except as you have informed the Editor(s) and Press in writing; that you have used all reasonable care to ensure that all facts and statements in the Article are true; and that the Article is not defamatory or violates of any right of privacy, common law, statutory copyright, or other personal or property rights. If copyright to the Article has been registered with the Library of Congress, you will promptly transfer the copyright to the Press. Should the Article contain material that requires written permission from another party, such permission shall be obtained at your own expense from the copyright owner and sent to the editor of the Journal.

5. The Press shall provide one complimentary print copy of the journal issue upon request. Otherwise you may access the PDF copy of your article from the issue of the journal in which your essay appears, available via the Press's *Antipodes* Digital Commons website. Additional print copies may be purchased from the Press.
