## Elder abuse

14.6% Estimated Prevalence (60 years + in community).

Sub-types: Financial (42%) Psychological (35%), Neglect (10%), Physical (8%), Social (5%), Sexual (0.1%)<sub>2</sub>


Perpetrators<sub>2</sub>:

95% family members ('trust'); 15% 'non-trust'

#### **Risk Factors**




(Socio)ecological model of risk of Elder Abuse<sub>3,4</sub>:

- Individual: dependency/disability, low income, gender, age, ethnicity/diverse background
- Perpetrator: mental health issues, substance abuse, dependency, criminal record, childhood FDV, Panviolence, education, minority status, social isolation
- Relationship: family culture, relationship dynamics
- Community: geographical location, degree of service support and availability
- Societal: ageist stereotypes, cultural norms

**Primary prevention:** information, education, screening

**Secondary responses:** Risk assessment, referral, advocacy, counselling, mediation, specialist legal/medical/financial

**Tertiary statutory:** Legal and Statutory responses
